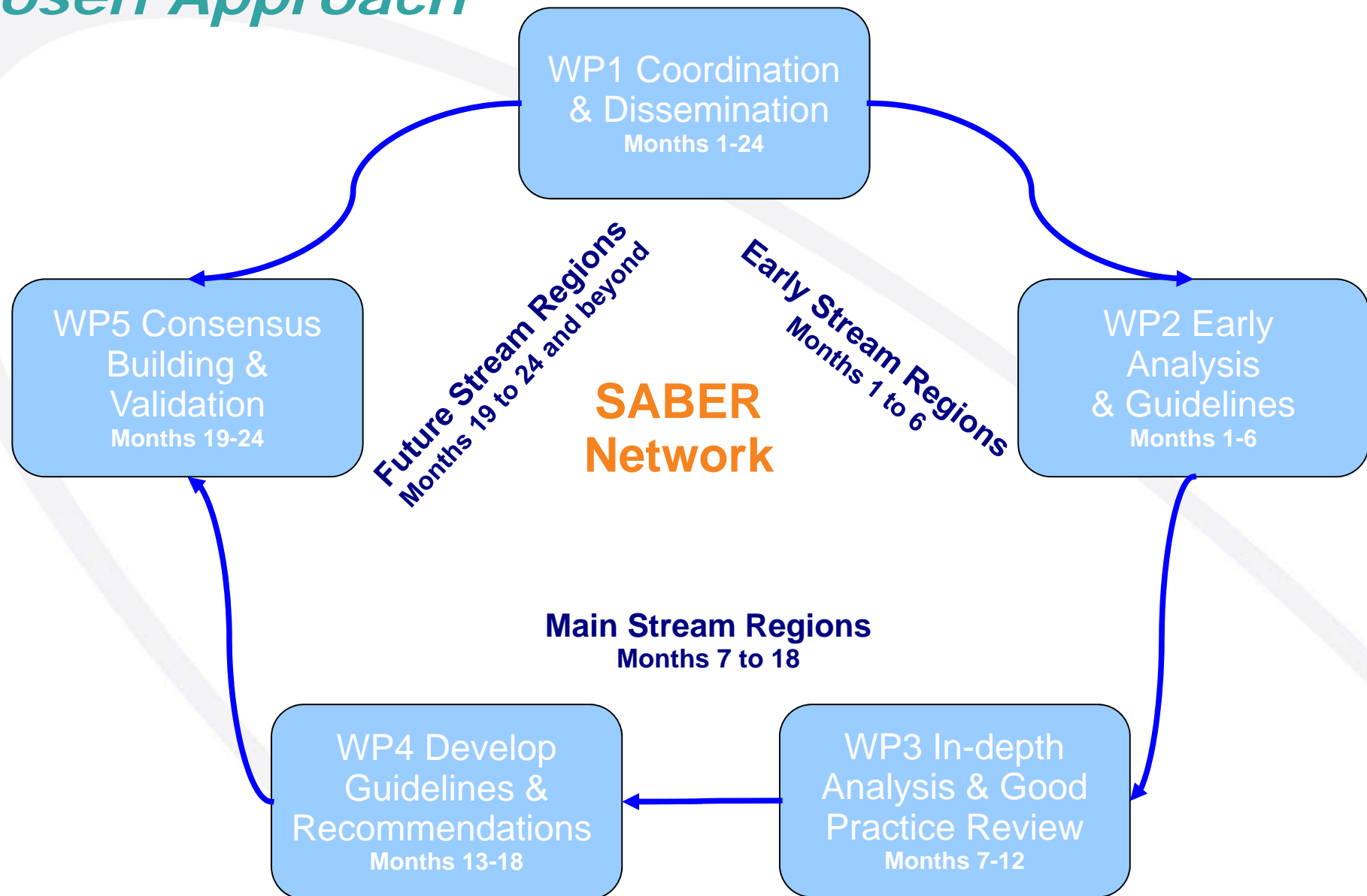
## • Objectives

- Raise awareness about existence and true capabilities of new generation satellite broadband
- Share best practices in the use of public funds
- Analyse roadblocks in public procurement and provide solutions
- Develop guidelines for deployment of satellite broadband
- Disseminate information to regions across Europe
- **SABER gather actors from the whole value chain:**
  - 22 regions and the satellite industry, coordinated by Piemonte region (CSI)
