General information and Travel recommendations:

- The fastest way to get from the **airport of Turin - Caselle**, that is 15 km away from the city centre, is by taxi that takes about 40 min. The taxi cost around 45 €, and the taxis can be found outside the arrival terminal:

If you are staying in any hotel in the city centre you can walk, should you stay further:

Bus/Tram: To plan your journey by tram or bus from your accommodation to the meeting, check the 5T website:

The tickets cost 1,50 €, and have to be purchased in one of the newsstands, bars or in one of the small tobacco stores with a big **T** as a sign. You cannot usually buy tickets onboard. When you get on the tram or the bus, you have to punch the ticket before the first stop. The tickets are valid for 90 minutes.
