COI is an expert nongovernmental organization established in 1998.

COI's mission is the support of Information Society development at regional level.

COI facilitates technology transfer and adoption of European e-development good practices.

The strategic dimension of COI activities consists of **cooperation with public sector** (with **particular attention paid to local governments)**.

COI is considered to be a think tank in possession of a strong research background.

Working practice used by COI experts consists of close cooperation with public partners and the ability to formulate practical recommendations for an improvement of the economic and social growth in the region – rooted in European knowledge and local specifics.
