
## Best practices in France

2 different funding models for satellite terminals to bridge the digital divide (1% of the French households is still ineligible to DSL lines):

- Calls for tenders
- Vouchers

Positive experience with **vouchers** in France

Map of the **maximum subsidies** that users of satellite broadband can receive for the purchase and the installation of the equipment in France by département



### Région Auvergne:

- -One of the best region in France in terms of **DSL coverage** (99.6% in 2009)
- But still 0.4% of the households (2624 lines) were not covered
- To achieve 100% broadband coverage, satellite broadband solution is subsidised. **Result:** by November 2012, 1000 KIT were subsidised e.g 38% coverage of the ineligible to

**DSL** lines









## Auvergne and 100% broadband coverage

**Test of eligibility** with the phone number line on the website of the Regional broadband programme.

**Competition** is respected: choice between 5 satellite internet service providers

#### Funding model chosen: vouchers

➤ 400 for the purchase of the satellite equipment and € 200 for the installation
